- 5:30 p.m. Stations of the Cross, Cathedral  
*We walk the stations together as we pray and read scripture.*
- 7 p.m. Le Chemin de la Croix by Marcel Dupré, Cathedral  
*Mark the last steps of Jesus to the cross with music and poetry. Hayley Tuller, narrator; Timothy Tuller, organ.*

## Holy Saturday, April 20

- 9 a.m. Holy Saturday liturgy followed by decorating the Cathedral with lilies.



## Easter Sunday, April 21

- 6 a.m. The Great Vigil, Cathedral  
*The first celebration of Easter begins in candlelight with Holy Baptism. We greet the sunrise with The Great Noise and Holy Eucharist. (Bring your noisemakers!)*
  - 7:30 a.m. Easter Breakfast, Taliaferro
  - 9 a.m. Festal Eucharist & Flowering of the Cross  
*Children are encouraged to bring fresh cut flowers for the cross.*
  - 10 a.m. Easter Egg Hunt, Cathedral Park (children age 7 & under)
  - 11:15 a.m. Festal Eucharist with Bishop Howard (incense will be used)
